You will receive a warm welcome with home made cakes and tea on arrival and beautiful en suite bedrooms with stunning views across the open countryside.

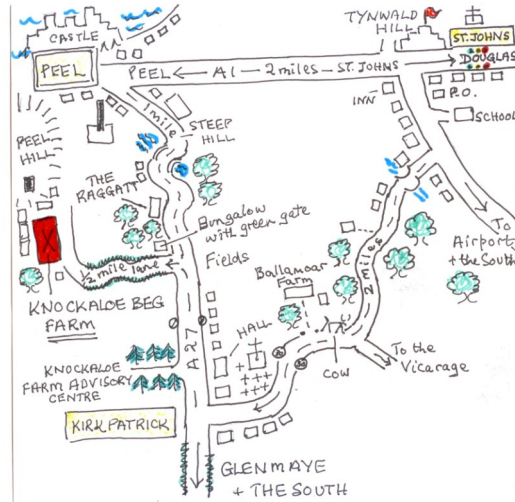
Out side we have a walled garden and two patio areas for guests to use.

Knockaloe Beg farmhouse has recently been rebuilt to replicate the original building, which dated back to the 16th century. We have three double or twin en-suite bedrooms, all with TV and tea-making facilities. There are full internet services available and excellent mobile reception.

There is a shared lounge for the sole use of guests, with comfortable seating and a beautiful 300 year old, circular oak dining table where guests eat breakfast together. You can choose from a range of traditional Manx farmhouse breakfasts to the lighter continental style.



Local attractions

Guests may have as much or little involvement on the farm as they want. We can arrange farm tours, you may help with feeding chickens, collecting eggs, grooming the Shetland ponies and watching deliveries at lambing time!

The farm has the Isle of Man Coastal footpath running through it for 2 miles and there are countless other lovely tracks and wildlife to enjoy on foot and bike.



We can arrange sea kayaking, rock climbing, coasteering, pony trekking and guided walks.

There are also many beautiful Manx National Heritage sites to visit and beaches to explore. Peel with the Castle, golf, swimming pool, Museum and tennis is 5 minutes by car, St John's with it's Craft Centre only 10 minutes away. There are lovely views and a café at Dalby, 5 minutes by car.



Built for the Future

We, John & Fiona Anderson, have a shared vision for establishing a sustainable enterprise.

Accordingly the farmhouse is constructed with high levels of insulation and heated by a ground source heat pump, so avoiding the need for any fossil fuels.

We rear our own free range chickens (and children), manage 900 sheep and 200 milking cows.

We endeavour to provide breakfasts which are homemade, seasonal and locally grown or reared.

Natural products and materials are used throughout the house whenever possible.
